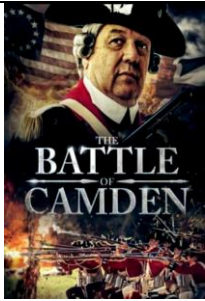
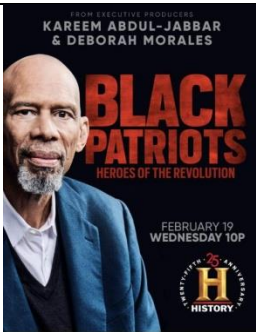
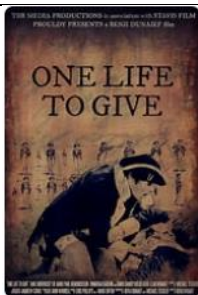


The American Revolutionary War In Movies
